THE KEEP FINFISH FREE ACT OF 2025



Introduced by Senators Cory Booker (D-NJ) and Dan Sullivan (R-AK) to:

"... chart a path built around the health of wild stocks and ocean ecosystems" (Sen. Booker)

"... ban risky fish farming operations in federal waters" (Sen. Sullivan)

THE ISSUE

Unchecked offshore aquaculture threatens working waterfronts, coastal economies, and ocean health.

These massive operations use millions of pounds of wild fish to feed farmed carnivores, spread pollution and disease, and are often run by multinational companies. They function like factory farms in the ocean, contaminating U.S. waters at the expense of fisheries, tourism, and local communities.

ENSURES consumer access to fresh, nutritious local seafood


